Following Facebook videos posted online Cllr Lane investigated the excavations recently being carried out at 'Land East of Horebeech Lane' (Cauldavon).

Wealden District Council had given approval for these works as the developer had complied with Conditions 9 (Archaeological Works) and 16 (Contamination and Remediation), set by the Inspector at the planning appeal.

We have been advised that the site was supervised by a certified ecologist and archaeologist to ensure compliance with all regulatory requirements.

The Parish Council would like to thank Cllr Gary Brockhurst for repainting the finger post on Ffords Lane in Vines Cross.

Also, a big thank you to Tim Joy who has done an excellent job tidying up the Memorial Garden.



There was also eventual success after 12 months of persistently chasing ESCC Highways and they have at last cut back the vegetation that blocked the Heathfield Road sign coming into the village and have repainted the white lines in the same location.

For information the Call Centre for the Flexibus is once again operating from 6.30am – 7.30pm Monday to Saturday excluding Bank Holidays. The Electoral Services Team at Wealden District Council are about to start the annual revision of the electoral register (annual canvass).

As part of the annual canvass, they will be contacting households in different ways including:

They will also be starting the postal vote renewal process for 2025/26. Following a change in the law, the maximum length of time a voter can hold a postal vote changed from indefinitely to a maximum period of three years.
