## WD/2025/6505/SO Land to the South of Horam (Coxlow Farm) Horam

Request for screening opinion for proposed residential development land to the South of Horam **HORAM PARISH COUNCIL** 

Thank you for your email dated 13<sup>th</sup> August 2025 regarding the parish council's request to convene a meeting prior to the decision date for the above application. This was in order to discuss the findings of a Landscape Sensitivity Report concerning Land to the South of Horam (Coxlow Farm) that the parish council has recently had commissioned. Members noted with disappointment that this would not be possible.

The HPC Planning & Highways Committee note that they are not consultees at this stage.

However, this development will change the shape of the whole of the Horam parish forever. It will be the biggest change to Horam since the railway nearly 200 years ago. Under these circumstances the council feel it is very important that they engage with yourselves throughout the whole process in order best protect the local community.

Please note the following comments made at the HPC Planning And Highways meeting of 20<sup>th</sup> August:

- Members noted with disappointment that the number of suggested dwellings had risen by 20% from 750 (which itself being on top of approximately 600 already approved and or built in the last ten years is wholly out of scale with its village location) to 900.
- It was felt that for a development of this size and scale, which would change the shape of the village, an Environmental Impact Assessment should be a requirement.
- The new section of additional land which has been added to the proposal (this section does
  not feature on the Draft Local Plan) would imply that a crossing of the Cinder Ghyll would be

required, unless there is a new junction with the A267. As the Wealden Ghylls are a very
distinct and unique habitat, we have grave concerns about potential degradation and damage
to that unique environment.

- This new proposal envelopes the Ghyll. Regulations regarding crossing such rivers should be adhered to. River pollution would be a real danger.
- The habitat, ancient woodland and wildflower meadows in and surrounding the Ghyll should be protected at all costs.

The Planning & Highways Committee hope you understand their concerns and I trust you will note the contents of this letter.
