ERECTION OF WINERY BUILDING TERRACE WITH ACCESSIBILITY RAMP TOGETHER WITH ASSOCIATED ALTERATIONS TO EXISTING BUILDING. Hidden Spring Vineyard, Vines Cross Road, Horam, TN21 0HG

The application was unanimously recommended for APPROVAL.

The Council's observations in respect of this application are as follows: -

The Council were pleased that the application accords with Policy HLE2 (relating to Employment proposals) insofar as it is well integrated with and makes as much use as practicable of existing structures, nor would it have a significant impact on landscape character.

In relation to the HNP Design policy, HCD4, it is agreed that the creation of a modest terrace and the associated installation of an access ramp at the Hidden Spring Vineyard would provide for a "beneficial enhancement to an established rural enterprise".

It is also agreed that "The use of steel and timber provides a rural, honest aesthetic, in keeping with the building's function."

The intention that "the entire installation will be wheelchair accessible, thereby improving inclusivity and meeting modern accessibility standards" is supported, although access through the site may need to be reviewed for this to be comfortable for wheelchair users.

The Council did express disappointment that the Planning Statement did not make any reference to the application in the context of the made HNP. The HNP being the most up-to-date and relevant development plan document.
